All grades except kindergarten will need standard 3.5 mm Stereo Headphones (the size used in a standard portable radio, Ipod, or computer—these can be purchased for \$1 at many dollar stores).

Raggedy Ann & Andy Preschool 3yr. old & 4 yr. old:

2 glue sticks, 1 Elmer's Glue, 2 pocket folders, 1 three ring 1" binder, 2 spiral notebooks, 1 small box of washable markers, 1 box of Kleenex, 1 package of small disposable cups.

Kindergarten:

A towel for resting (no plastic mats, please), 1 small pencil box, 1 coloring book, 2 bottles **Elmer's** glue, 4 glue sticks, 3-24-packs of Crayola crayons, a good square eraser, 1 pair of Fiskars metal scissors with rounded points, one 4 or 8 pk. Expo dry erase Markers-chisel tip (can be colored or black) for student use, 6 no. 2 pencils, Mead Primary Journal (K-2), 2 spiral note books, 1 box of washable markers and 1 pkg. of 3x5 lined note cards. The following items are optional, but would be appreciated: 1 box of Kleenex, 1 box of quart size and 1 box of gallon size zip-lock storage bags, and a container of Clorox wipes.

1st Grade:

10 sharpened #2 pencils, a good square eraser, plastic 5"x 8" pencil box, 3-24-packs of crayons, scissors, 1 Elmer's white glue, 8 glue sticks, 4 inexpensive folders- 1 red, 1 yellow, 1 green, 1 blue, one 4 or 8 pk. Expo Dry erase markers-chisel tip (red, blue, green & black) for student use. The following items are optional, but would be appreciated: one box of Kleenex, and a container of Clorox wipes. Please put student's name on each item.

2nd Grade:

10 sharpened #2 pencils, a good square eraser, plastic 5"X8" pencil box, colored pencils, 2-24 pack of crayons, 12" metric & inches ruler, 8 Elmers glue sticks, 1 Elmer's white glue, 1 wide lined spiral notebook, scissors, 4 inexpensive folders-1 red, 1 yellow, 1 green, 1 blue, one 4 or 8 package Expo Dry Erase Markers-chisel tip (can be colored or black). The following items are optional, but would be appreciated: 2 boxes of Kleenex, 1 box of quart size zip-lock storage bags, and a container of Clorox wipes. Please put student's name on each item.

3rd Grade:

1 glue stick, 1 Elmer's white glue, 8 #2 pencils, erasers, one hand-held pencil sharpener, pointed-end scissors, crayons, colored pencils, ruler with inches and centimeters, 3 wide lined spiral notebooks (red, blue & yellow), 3 folders (red, blue & yellow), a case or holder for carrying pencils, 2 colored checking pens for student-correcting, 1 highlighter. The following items are optional, but would be appreciated: 1 dry-erase marker, 2 boxes of Kleenex, 1 box of zip-lock storage bags (snack size) and 2 containers Clorox wipes.

4th Grade:

4 spiral wide-line notebooks (no wireless please), 2 plain yellow **plastic** folders, 1 folder of your choice, crayons and pre-sharpened colored pencils, scissors, 1 bottle white glue, one 4 or 8 pk. black Expo dry erase markers (fine-point preferred) for student use, 48 #2 pencils (**no mechanical pencils**), 8 inexpensive red pens for student correcting, 1 highlighter, 1 large eraser, 1 pkg. pencil-top erasers, plastic pencil box, 1 pkg. 1 1/2 x 2 inch Post-it notes, headphones for plugging into computer. The following items are optional, but would be appreciated: 2 boxes of Kleenex, 2 containers of Clorox wipes.

5th Grade:

Headphones for plugging into computer, 4 spiral wide line notebooks (no wireless please as the pages fall out), 1 Composition Notebook, 1 pack of 3X5 index cards, 1 pkg. of 1½ by 2 in. Post-It notes, crayons and pre-sharpened colored pencils, color-coded folders (prefer plastic for durability): 2 yellow, 1 green, 1 red, and 1 of your choice, 4 pk. fine point black Expo markers, 24-#2 pencils (no mechanical), 2 erasers, inexpensive colored pens (no black), yellow highlighter, scissors, Elmer's white glue and plastic pencil box. The following are optional, but would be appreciated: 2 boxes of Kleenex, 1 container of Clorox Wipes, and 1 box of quart size zip-lock storage bags. Please initial or label all items.
