Preschool Registration for Fall 2018

Registration will be held on May 7 from 7:00- 8:00 PM. Registration fee for the Caterpillar classes is \$40. One month's tuition of \$80 is required as a deposit to hold your child's place in preschool. Children must be 3 by Sept. 15, 2017 and toilet trained. Caterpillars meet on Tuesday and Thursday at 8:00 - 10:00 OR 10:15-12:15. If we have enough enrollment we will have 2 sections of Caterpillars. The cost is \$80 per month. Transportation for preschool is the parents' responsibility. Financial Assistance applications will be available in August. Butterfly classes meet Monday, Wednesday, and Friday at 8:00 - 11:20 OR 11:50 - 3:10. There is an instructional materials fee of \$50 but no tuition for these classes. You must sign up even though the classes are free. There is a limit of 20 students per section. Transportation for the Butterfly classes is the parents' responsibility. Please call 319-342-3141 if you cannot come to registration on May 7. We will also accept registrations any time after May 7.

Superintendent Travis Fleshner announced that based on action by the Union School Board at their April 9, 2018, meeting, the final day of school for TK-12 students will be Friday, June 1, with an 11 A.M. dismissal. Last week's snow day was also considered. District students will have met the State-mandated requirement for instructional hours and will therefore not have to return for the last three school weather make-up days that were scheduled for June 4, 5, and 6.

We are in the process of compiling class lists for next year. We believe we have a competent and experienced teaching staff which works hard to provide the best education possible for all students. We take many factors into consideration when putting together these lists. They are: number balance, gender balance, behavior balance, and academic balance, which involves Title I reading, ELP, and Resource students. If you have a **special concern based on only educational reasons and not in the area of social reasons** for your child's placement next year, please contact me at the elementary office. **This year, we are using our FAST data to help place students to have balanced classrooms. Due to the new state mandated FAST assessments, weekly progress monitoring, and interventions, parent special concerns will be considered but may not be able to be met. We have to keep a balance of student academics with the FAST progress monitoring and assessments in each classroom.**
