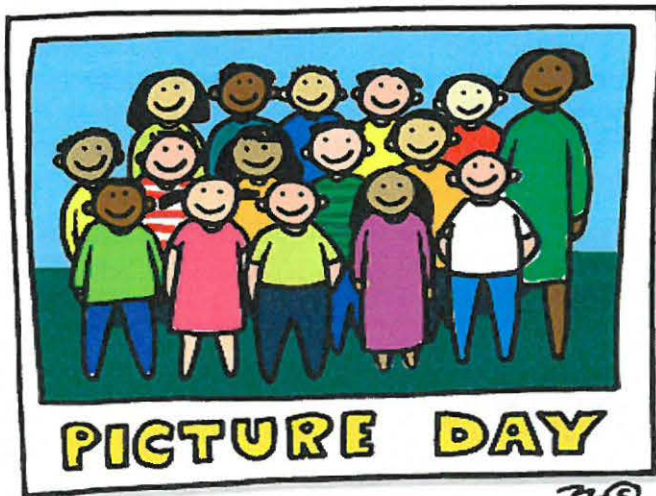

## 2nd Home Football Game Tonight

Our second varsity home football game is tonight. A reminder that there is **No Smoking allowed on the Union Community School District grounds** pursuant to the Iowa Smokefree Air Act. The school does not provide direct supervision of students, but will uphold appropriate student behavior and student expectations as follows: 1. Ideally, elementary students should sit with their parents or in small parent-supervised groups in the bleachers or on the hill and **watch the game.** 2. Students are **not allowed to bring footballs** to the game. 3. **No students are allowed on the practice field.** 4. We also are asking that students dispose of all plastic bottles properly in the waste cans available. **No kicking or throwing of pop bottles will be allowed.** **Also we ask that students do not sit or stand in the middle of the brick retaining wall under the scoreboard.** Your cooperation is needed and very much appreciated. We want students to have fun and show their school spirit in a positive way.

## Morning Drop off Zone Reminders

A reminder to parents that your help is needed before school to ensure the safety of all children and also provide smooth drop zone procedures. We are asking that if parents need to park their car and come into the building with their child, that they **park at the far end of the drop off zone past the sign.** This needs to be available for buses and also parents who are just dropping their children off to school from 7:30-8:05. **Parents who need to come in the building need to park at the end of the drop off lane.
