

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED
ISSUANCE OF APPROXIMATELY \$10,500,000 SCHOOL
INFRASTRUCTURE SALES, SERVICES AND USE TAX
REVENUE BONDS

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of the Union Community School District, in the Counties of Black Hawk, Benton, Buchanan and Tama, State of Iowa, will hold a public hearing upon its proposed issuance of approximately \$10,500,000 School Infrastructure Sales, Services and Use Tax Revenue Bonds, which may be issued in one or more series over multiple fiscal years, pursuant to Iowa Code Sections 423F.2 and 423F.4, for the purpose of providing funds to remodel, repair, improve, and equip existing school buildings, including HVAC, electrical, roofing, interior finishes, and site improvements, and to currently refund the outstanding School Infrastructure Sales, Services and Use Tax Revenue Bonds, Series 2017, dated December 28, 2017, including costs of issuance and a debt service reserve fund if required by the purchaser. Any bond proceeds remaining after completion of this project will be used for other school infrastructure projects as authorized by the School District's Revenue Purpose Statement.

The hearing will be held in the Union High School Board Room, 200 Adams Street, La Porte City, Iowa, on February 16, 2026, at 6:00 P.M.
